Dayne Dudley has made a career of sports cartooning. His clients are a Who's Who in Sports.

Only a partial list includes the Kansas City Royals, Atlanta Braves, USA Wrestling, Missouri Sports Hall of Fame, National Softball Hall of Fame, Jim Thorpe Association, National Wrestling Hall of Fame, Sports Illustrated, ESPN, TNN, NASCAR, World Football League, NCAA, McGraw-Hill, Stan Musial, Mickey Mantle and broadcaster Harry Caray. Other clients include the Oak Ridge Boys, Bill Cosby, ABC Radio/Television and Universal Studios.

In addition to sports illustration, which include realistic portraits, he has produced Hall of Fame induction prints, humor panels, comic strips, caricatures, children's books and magazines, games and puzzles, cartoon mascot designs, Christmas cards and various art for marketing and promotion

A recent production is a puzzle feature for Major League Baseball, which is included in game programs and aimed at children.

His covers and feature cartoons have long graced sports programs of over 500 colleges and universities from coast to coast, including Oklahoma, Nebraska, Florida State, Oklahoma State, Kansas State, Washington, Hawaii, Nevada, USC, Wichita State, Louisiana State, Alabama, Army, Navy, Penn State, Florida, Slippery Rock and many, many others.

Dayne has been honored with twelve "Best in the Nation" awards from COSIDA (the College Sports Information Directors of America).

He is a graduate of Wichita State University with a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. He was a varsity baseball player there as well.

He was cartoonist/illustrator for the Tulsa Tribune, with an emphasis on sports cartoons, for 13 years. He left that position to begin a freelance career that has extended over 30 years. In addition to his art production, he frequently teaches college-level courses in the use of Prismacolor pencils, his favorite art medium, and other phases of commercial art.
